## PLACE INSCRIPTION

- 1. PLACE makes room for the theory and practice of analysis in the U.S. in a return to Freud via the contemporary critique and topology of Lacan.
- 2. Anyone applying to work in the Sclinic (School or Clinic) must fill out the form below and return it to the secretary at: PLACE@topoi.net.
- 3. This information is for internal purposes only (scheduling, course and event announcement, etc.) and will not be shared with anyone.
- 4. Because PLACE does not require those applying to have a previous academic background or skill, the statement of your school or professional background is optional.
- 5. What would help, however, is a statement of what you are looking to achieve, why you chose PLACE, and how you would like to work in the field.
- 6. Though not necessary, talking with a trustee on the structure of PLACE may help orient your participation.
- 7. Though PLACE is certified by the California Board of Education for the teaching of psychoanalysis it is not accredited. This means course credits are only transferable on a case-by-case basis.
- 8. Just as there are no segregative measures prohibiting participation by a potential applicant, there are no time limits on the duration that it will take to confirm a practice of analysis through PLACE.
- 9. The protocol for the transmission of analysis cartels, courses, procedures of the pass, clinic, library, and virtual classroom is made available to each person enrolled.
- 10. The General Assembly meets twice yearly and is open to Trustees and Adherents.
- 11. Two cartels and one course are currently offered per semester (see *Cartel Procedures*).
- 12. A juried event for the confirmation of the soundness of a work the Pass may be requested by any trustee or adherent of PLACE.
- 13. On the achievement of the Pass, the participant is inscribed as analyst of PLACE (see *Pass Procedures*).
- 14. It is up to each person to assume these structures in their proper manner, while reformulating, critiquing, and producing new ones to take their place. In short, there are no academic programs at PLACE, only structures that are constructed,

de-constructed, and reconstructed with each new generation.
